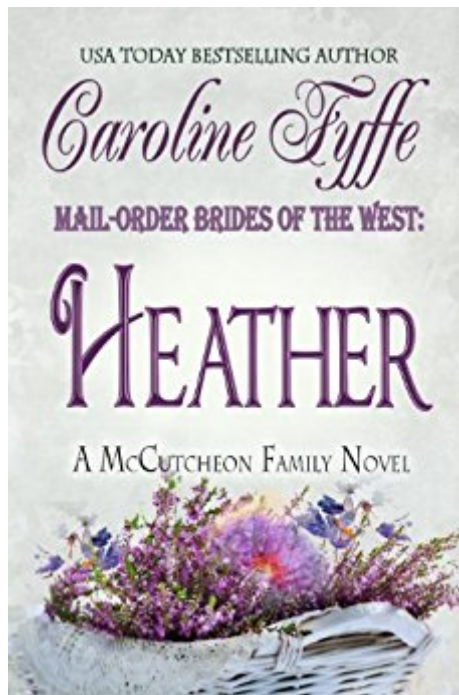


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Mail-Order Brides Of The West: Heather (McCutcheon Family Series Book 4)

We also meet one of Heather's brothers who also journeys west as well as her sister Sally who is a prolific letter writer. This book series is part of two other series: Montana Sky and The McCutcheon Family. It is an integral part of the McCutcheon saga and occurs before most of the Montana Sky stories.
