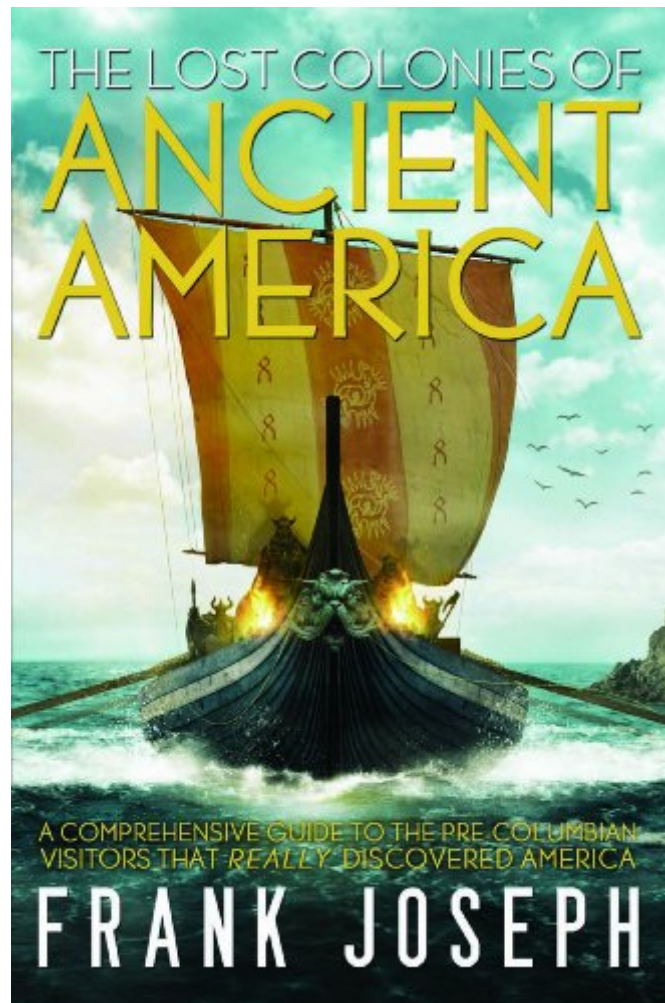

The Lost Colonies Of Ancient America



Synopsis

Was America truly unknown to the outside world until Christopher Columbus "discovered" it in 1492? Did the Phoenicians, who circumnavigated the African continent in 600 bc, never consider sailing farther? If so, how are we to account for an Egyptian temple accidentally unearthed by Tennessee Valley Authority workers in 1935? What is a beautifully crafted metal plate with the image of a Phoenician woman doing in the Utah desert? And who can explain the discovery of Viking houses and wharves excavated outside Boston?

Joseph's book contains numerous examples of cross-cultural encounters between the Middle East and the Americas. For instance, the pre-Incan people of coastal Peru built similar stepped pyramids as their middle eastern counterparts. The Sumerians built large reed boats that could traverse

virtually any wind at sea. The Andes Mountains were accessible to Sumerian sailors around the African Cape of Good Hope and crossing the South Atlantic to South American shores. Cotton used in Peru in the 4th Millennium BC had fibers from the cross-bred Asian American plant. The pre-Incan "Pyramid of the Kings" had the precise correlations in architectural layout as the Victory Temple in the Upper Nile Valley. The chemicals related to cocoa and nicotine in several Egyptian mummies confirm reciprocal trade between the Mediterranean Basin and the Americas. The survival of a Minoan Crete labyrinthine design at the Casa Grande, Arizona suggests that Bronze Age visitors from the Eastern Mediterranean made an indelible impact on the American Southwest which carries over to today's Pima Indians. The existence of a purple shell industry confirms Phoenician colonization of coastal S. America. This fact alone is one of Carthage's most closely held trade protocols. Important Native American words have parallels in Japan; thereby proving a potential cultural or trade linkage. Joseph's book has many pictures of ancient sites and artifacts like Iraq's Ziggurat, the BES Egyptian god, Arizona's Casa Grande petroglyph, San Lorenzo's Olmec Colossal stonehead, the Zheng He statue in China, the Kanawha Madonna and others.

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
