

This is a good textbook for an introduction to geography course. It is a thematic or systematic

approach rather than a regional approach to the subject. It has good supporting materials for students, although Mastering Geography is not included in the cost of the text. It has excellent pictures for helping to make points and some good charts and diagrams. The paper is of slick quality and does give off glare when reading. It has some helpful materials that you can avail yourself of using your cell phone and scanning the code, although I am not sure how much a student would use this feature. The writing seems a little stiff and the text seems perhaps too factual and less student involving. Students may have more of a tendency to hunt and skip rather than fully read the text, or at least that is my impression. The end of chapter review is good. A somewhat unique alternative to look at is Introduction to Contemporary Geography by the same publisher. It offers some different possibilities.
